

## Lesson 11 - Wearing the New Self

### I. Col 3:1-17

- A. Introduction: This chapter begins the section on the practical implications of your baptism for daily life. It covers how you are to behave ethically, morally, and relationally as one who has been set apart for God's purposes and is now a Christian.
- B. Terms and Concepts
  - 1. **The Right Hand of God** - The right hand of God is both a place of honor and a place of authority. Scripture reminds us that after Christ was raised from the dead, he was seated at the right hand of God. This is similar to the designation of Jesus as "Lord" and Jesus as "King." These are designations of authority.
  - 2. **Scythian** - These were the peoples that lived north of the Black Sea.
  - 3. **Barbarian** - This was not originally a negative term. It is the designation for all non-Greek speaking peoples. It is thought that this word derived from the way they sounded when speaking their language - "bar-ba-bar...etc."
  - 4. **Admonish** - To advise, warn, or rebuke mildly but earnestly
  - 5. **Psalms, hymns & spiritual songs** - The word, Psalm, comes from the Old Testament, and refers simply to a song, usually from the book of Psalms or in the manner of songs from the book of Psalms. Hymns were festive songs or praise sung to a hero, in this case, God. Spiritual songs are songs with a spiritual theme. There is not a huge distinction between the three of these as they are all considered sacred music.
